MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS January 14, 2014

THE STATE OF TEXAS

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 162 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, at the offices of Norton Rose Fulbright, 1301 McKinney St., Suite 5100, Houston, Texas, on January 14, 2014 at 2:00 p.m.; whereupon the roll was called of the members of the Board, to-wit:

Susan McClure, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Ms. Patty Rodriguez of Bob Leared Interests ("BLI"), tax assessor and collector for the District; Ms. Karrie Kay of Mrytle Cruz, Inc., bookkeeper for the District; Mr. Chris Hoffman of H2O Consulting ("H2O"), operator of the District's facilities; Mr. Jonathan St. Romain of Brown & Gay Engineers, Inc. ("BGE"), engineers for the District; and Ms. Jana Cogburn and Ms. Katherine Wolpert of Fulbright & Jaworski LLP ("F&J"), attorneys for the District.

The President called the meeting to order in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of Certificates of Posting of which are attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and the following business was transacted:

- 1. Approve Minutes. Consideration was given to the approval of the minutes of the regular meeting of December 10, 2013, copies of which were previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Parrish, seconded by Director Johnson, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of December 10, 2013, as presented.
- 2. Review Bookkeeper's Report and authorize payment of bills. Ms. Kay presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, the Investment Report, the Operating Budget, the Cash Flow Comparison and the Energy Usage Report, copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit "B". Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director McClure, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Bookkeeper's Report, to authorize payment of check nos. 4197 through 4213 from the Operating Account, each in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes described in the Bookkeeper's Report, and to approve the Investment Report.
- 3. Review Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills. Ms. Rodriguez presented to and reviewed with the Board the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report, and a list of delinquent taxpayers, copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit "C." Ms. Rodriguez stated that the District has collected 70.3% of its 2013 taxes. Ms. Rodriguez presented to and reviewed with the Board the Delinquent Tax Report from Perdue,

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Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott L.L.P., a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "D". Ms. Rodriguez stated that the amounts shown on the Delinquent Tax Report are the 2012 tax base, and do not include penalty and interest Ms. Rodriguez noted that with regard to the Texas Enrichment, Inc./Sand Castle Montessori Academy, the District Delinquent Tax Attorney has requested an order of sale and that abstract judgment was filed. Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report, and the Delinquent Tax Report, and to authorize payment of check no. 1002 and nos. 1054 through 1057 from the Tax Account in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes described in the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report.

- 4. Consider Property Tax Exemptions. Ms. Cogburn presented to and reviewed with the Board the Order Adopting Exemptions From Taxation, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "E". Ms. Cogburn noted that the District currently has a tax exemption in place for individuals who are disabled or are 65 years of age or older. Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director McClure, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to adopt an Order Authorizing Exemption from Taxation for \$25,000 of the appraised value of residence homesteads within the District for individuals who are disabled or are 65 years of age or older.
- 5. Adopt Resolution Authorizing Additional Penalty on Delinquent Taxes Under Sections 33.07, 33.11, and 33.08 Tax Code-April 1st (personal property) and July 1st (other property). Ms. Cogburn presented to and reviewed with the Board the Order Authorizing Additional Penalty on Delinquent Taxes, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "F". Upon motion by Director Parrish, seconded by Director Johnson, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Resolution Authorizing Additional Penalty on Delinquent Taxes remaining delinquent on April 1, 2014 for personal property and remaining delinquent on July 1, 2014 for other property.
- 6. Adopt Order Calling Directors Election. Ms. Cogburn presented to and reviewed with the Board the Order Calling 2014 Directors Election, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "G". The Board agreed to appoint Karen Odell as the Presiding Judge and Donna Swanky as the Alternate Presiding Judge for the 2014 Directors Election. The Board agreed to hold the election at 7646 Club Lake Drive Houston, Texas 77095, within the District, and that the entire District shall be and its boundaries are designated as one election precinct. Upon motion by Director McClure, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Order Calling Directors Election.
- 7. Adopt Appointment of Agent for the 2014 Directors Election. Ms. Cogburn presented to and reviewed with the Board the Appointment of Agent for 2014 Directors Election, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "H". Upon motion by Director McClure, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Appointment of Agent for the 2014 Directors Election and to appoint Katherine Wolpert of F&J as the District's agent to perform the duties in connection with the 2014 Directors Election.
- 8. Adopt Resolution Authorizing Publication of Notice of Intent Not to Use An Electronic Voting System. Ms. Cogburn presented to and reviewed with the Board the

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Resolution Authorizing Publication of Notice of Intent Not to Use An Electronic Voting System, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "I". Ms. Cogburn stated that the District is eligible for exemption from the acquisition, lease or use of an electronic voting system for the 2014 Directors Election. Upon motion by Director McClure, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Resolution Authorizing Publication of Notice of Intent Not to Use An Electronic Voting System for the 2014 Directors Election.

- 9. Approve Notice of Exemption From Use of Electronic Voting System. Ms. Cogburn presented to and reviewed with the Board the Notice of Exemption From Use of Electronic Voting System, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "J". Ms. Cogburn stated that the District is required to publish notice of its intent not to use an electronic voting system for the 2014 Directors Election. Upon motion by Director McClure, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to authorize publication of such notice.
- 10. Operations Report. Mr. Hoffman presented to and reviewed with the Board the Operations Report for the month of December 2013, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "K". Mr. Hoffman reported that the District pumped 523,000 gallons of water and purchased 7,583,000 gallons of water from the West Harris County Regional Water Authority during the last period and that H2O accounted for 94.26% of the water pumped and purchased by the District during the last period.

Mr. Hoffman reported that the TCEQ completed an inspection at the Water Plant. He stated that no deficiencies were noted during the inspection and that H2O is waiting to receive the final report.

Mr. Hoffman reported that H2O winterized the control lines and valves throughout the water plant site. He noted that H2O purchased heaters and tested them throughout the water plant.

Mr. Hoffman reported that H2O repaired a tapline leak and replaced the landscaping at 15430 Willow River at a final cost of \$1,407.12.

Mr. Hoffman reported that the valve repairs for Northmead Village and Middlegate Village have begun at an estimated cost of \$6,050.00.

Mr. Hoffman reported on sewer line maintenance and stated that Phase 'C' cleaning and televising in Middlegate Village has been scheduled. Mr. Hoffman requested permission to revise the budget for the sewer line maintenance from an estimated cost of \$20,000.00 to an estimated cost of \$28,000.00. The Board agreed to revise the budget and directed H2O to begin Phase 'C' cleaning and televising at an estimated cost of \$28,000.00.

11. Engineer's Report. Mr. St. Romain presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "L".

Mr. St. Romain reported on the Pebble Lake Drive Pavement Repair and stated that Camino Services is scheduled to begin the repair at an estimated cost of \$31,310.00 on January 22, 2014.

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Mr. St. Romain reported on the Sanitary Sewer Repair for Northmead Village and stated that there is no pay estimate this month. Mr. St. Romain stated that Phase 'C' Cleaning and Televising in Middlegate Village has been scheduled, and presented to and reviewed with the Board a map showing lines to be televised, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "M".

- Mr. St. Romain reported on the Water Plant driveway and presented to and reviewed with the Board the Easement and Right-of-Way Agreement that the District previously entered into with the CCA to share the driveway, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "N". Discussion ensued. Upon motion by Director Parrish, seconded by Director Johnson, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to repair the District's portion of the driveway and to amend the 2014-2015 District budget to include a line item for the repair and future maintenance of the driveway. Mr. St. Romain stated that he will obtain quotes, and report back to the Board and to the Bookkeeper with regard to the amount of funds that will be required to repair and maintain the driveway.
- 12. Discuss CJOB meeting. Ms. Cogburn reported that she attended the January CJOB meeting and stated that H2O and AECOM reported on the Bar Screen Evaluation and presented two proposals to replace the existing Bar Screen: 1.) JWC Environmental could install a Fine Screen to replace the current Bar Screen at an estimated cost of \$145,945.00, or 2.) NTS could rebuild the current Bar Screen at an estimated cost of \$25,880.00. Ms. Cogburn noted that CJOB agreed to defer action on this matter until the next meeting. Ms. Cogburn stated that No. 188 approved plans to implement the three-month trial of the Micro-Solve grease reducing product at their Lift Station No. 1. Ms. Cogburn reported that CJOB approved the Texas Buy Board Ramtech Building Option for the Operations Building.
- 13. Discuss Future Meeting Location. The Board discussed future meeting times and locations. The Board agreed to hold its next meeting at the offices of H2O Consulting on February 10, 2014 at 2:00 pm. The Board agreed to discuss the March through December meeting times and locations at the February meeting.
- 14. Discuss District Website. The Board discussed changes to the District Website. Director McClure stated that the website has not been updated. Director Odell stated that he will contact the Website Administrator regarding the updates.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.



WHEREAS, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 162 (the "District") has contracted with private legal counsel to enforce collection of delinquent property taxes pursuant to Section 6.30, Texas Tax Code or, alternatively, another taxing unit that collects taxes for the District has contracted with private legal counsel under Section 6.30;

WHEREAS, such private legal counsel is entitled to 20% of the delinquent taxes, penalty and interest which are collected and subject to the contract;

WHEREAS, Section 33.07 of the Texas Tax Code authorizes the District to provide that taxes that become delinquent on or after February 1 of a year but not later than May 1 of that year and remain delinquent on July 1 of the year in which they become delinquent incur an additional penalty which may not exceed the amount of compensation specified in the contract with an attorney under Section 6.30 of the Tax Code, in order to defray costs of collection;

WHEREAS, Section 33.11 of the Texas Tax Code authorizes the District to provide that taxes on tangible personal property that become delinquent on or after February 1 of a year may incur an additional penalty on a date that occurs before July 1 of the year in which the taxes become delinquent if the District has contracted with an attorney under Section 6.30 and the taxes on the personal property become subject to the attorney's contract before July 1 of the year in which the taxes become delinquent; and

WHEREAS, Section 33.08 of the Texas Tax Code authorizes the District to provide that taxes that become delinquent on or after June 1 under Sections 26.07(f), 26.15(e), 31.03, 31.031, 31.032, or 31.04 incur an additional penalty which may not exceed the amount of compensation specified in the contract with an attorney under Section 6.30 of the Tax Code, in order to defray costs of collection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDER by the Board of Directors of the District that:

- (1) all 2013 taxes on tangible personal property which become delinquent on or after February 1, 2014 and remain delinquent on April 1, 2014 incur an additional penalty equal to the compensation specified in the contract with the attorney to be paid in connection with the collection of the delinquent taxes.

The Board adopts such form of notice as part of its election practices for this election and subsequent elections, until and unless such procedure is changed by formal action of the Board.
- 7. In the event the Secretary of the Board certifies that a candidate is unopposed for election to an office, the Board hereby determines that, pursuant to Sections 2.051 through 2.054 of the Election Code, it will declare such unopposed candidate elected to the

office without an election. The Board adopts the practice of canceling elections when permitted pursuant to Sections 2.052 through 2.053 of the Election Code as part of its election practices for this election and subsequent elections, until and unless such procedure is changed by formal action of the Board.

- 8. Voting will be conducted by paper ballot or by electronic voting system certified by the Texas Secretary of State as complying with the requirements of an accessible voting system established by the Help America Vote Act, if requested by a qualified voter in the District not later than the 45th day before the date of the election. The Board hereby adopts the use of paper ballots and, if requested in accordance with the law, the electronic voting system described above as part of its election practices for this election and subsequent elections, until and unless such procedure is changed by formal action of the Board.
- 9. The officers of the Board are each authorized to evidence adoption of this Order and directed to do any and all things legal and necessary to hold such election and otherwise to carry out the intent hereof.
- 10. In case any provision in this Order shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

- 2. The Board hereby appoints <u>Katherine Wolpert</u> of Fulbright & Jaworski LLP, a member of Norton Rose Fulbright, as the District's agent to perform the duties provided by Section 31.123 of the Election Code and to perform any other ministerial duties in connection with the election that may lawfully be performed by such agent.
- 3. The Secretary and the Board hereby confirm and ratify all actions previously taken by such agent in connection with the 2014 Directors Election.

- 1. The Board hereby finds that it is eligible for the exemption from the acquisition, lease or use of an electronic voting system under Section 49.111 of the Texas Water Code.

The Board hereby directs the District's election agent to arrange for publication of a notice in a newspaper of general circulation in an area that includes the District regarding the District's intention to hold an election without providing a voting station that meets the requirements for accessibility under 42 USC Section 15481(a)(3) either on election day or during the period for early voting by personal appearance, in substantially the form attached hereto.
- 3. The Board hereby directs the District's election agent to notify the Board in the event she receives a request for an accessible voting system not later than the 45th day before the date of the election so that arrangements can be made to provide an accessible voting station on election day and during the period for early voting by personal appearance, as required by Section 49.111 of the Texas Water Code.





FRIENDSWOOD DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, hereinafter called "Grantor", for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, has granted, and by these presents does hereby grant unto HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 162, hereinafter called "Grantee", and its successors and assigns, a non-exclusive access and utility easement and right-of-way on, over and across the lands described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Grantor hereby reserves herefrom, for itself and its successors and assigns, with the right of assignment in whole or in part, the right to the full and complete enjoyment of the lands subjected to the easement herein granted, except that any such use shall not unreasonably interfere with the rights of Grantee herein or its successors and assigns.
