MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS August 25, 2014

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF HARRIS
HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 186

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 186 (the "District") met in special session, open to the public, at the offices of Fulbright & Jaworski LLP, 1301 McKinney, Suite 5100, Houston, Texas, at 12:00 p.m. on August 25, 2014; whereupon the roll was called of the members of the Board, to wit:

Gary Henderson, President Charles Bumpass, Vice President Carol Barnes, Secretary Brent Powell, Assistant Secretary Alan Johnson, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present, except Director Barnes and Director Powell. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Mr. Josh Board and Mr. Chris Hoffman of H2O Consulting, Inc. ("H2O"), operators for the District; Ms. Michelle Guerrero and Ms. Stacey Wagner of Bob Leared Interests ("BLI"), tax assessor and collector for the District; Mr. Pat Carrigan of AECOM Technical Services, Inc. ("AECOM"), engineers for the District; Ms. Kim Shelnutt of Myrtle Cruz, Inc. ("MCI"), bookkeepers for the District; and Ms. Jana Cogburn and Ms. Helen Hau of Fulbright & Jaworski LLP ("F&J"), attorneys for the District.

The meeting was called to order and, in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of Certificates of Posting of which are attached hereto as Exhibit "A," the following business was transacted:

- 1. Public Comments. There were no comments from the public.
- **2. Minutes**. Consideration was given to the approval of the minutes of the meeting of July 15, 2014, a copy of which was previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director Bumpass, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the meeting of July 15, 2014, as presented.
- 3. Tax Assessor and Collector's Report. Ms. Guerrero presented to and reviewed with the Board the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B." Ms. Guerrero stated that as of July 31, 2014, the District had collected 98.5% of its 2013 taxes. Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director Bumpass, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report, and to authorize payment of check nos. 1004 through 1007 from the Tax Account in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes described in the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report.
- 4. Bookkeeper's Report and Payment of Bills. Ms. Shelnutt presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, the budget for fiscal year ending February 28, 2015, the cash flow comparison, the Strategic Partnership Payments from the City

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of Houston, the Investment Report, and the Deposit/Collateral Report, copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit "C." Upon motion by Director Bumpass, seconded by Director Johnson, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Bookkeeper's Report, to authorize payment of check nos. 7788 through 7815 from the Operating Account, each in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes described in the Bookkeeper's Report, and to approve the Investment Report.

- 5. Operations Report and Authorize Repairs and Action On Customer Requests. Mr. Hoffman presented to and reviewed with the Board the Operations Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "D." Mr. Hoffman reported that the District pumped 1,628,000 gallons of water and purchased 15,691,000 gallons of water from the West Harris County Regional Water Authority during the month of July. Mr. Hoffman reported that H2O accounted for 93.5% of the water pumped and purchased by the District during the last period.
- Mr. Hoffman reported that the air compressor for the water plant has been purchased and installed at a final cost of \$5,412.98.
- Mr. Hoffman reported that the control panel SCADA screen at the water plant was installed and is operational at a final cost of \$5,351.55.
- Mr. Hoffman reported that semi-annual chlorinator preventative maintenance is complete at a final cost of \$1,263.06.
- Mr. Hoffman recommended that the Board authorize advertising for bids for recoating of the District's hydrotanks. Mr. Hoffman recommended taking the hydrotanks out of service for sandblasting and recoating in late October or early November. Discussion ensued.
- Mr. Hoffman reported that the annual load test for the lift station's generator is complete at a final cost of \$470.83.
- Mr. Hoffman reported that H2O investigated settlement near the manhole at 15922 Echo Lodge. Mr. Hoffman stated that infiltration was found at the manhole and that H2O sealed the manhole from top to bottom at a final cost of \$1,440.75.
- Mr. Hoffman reported that H2O purchased and installed the Evergreen Southwest product Micro-solve to treat the Lakeview Haven sewer line at a final cost of \$3.873.75.
- Mr. Hoffman requested that the Board authorize Phase Four cleaning and televising of the District's sewer lines at an estimated cost of \$20,000.00.
- Mr. Hoffman reviewed with the Board a letter from a resident regarding high water bills, a copy of which is attached to the Operations Report. Mr. Board noted that H2O is scheduled to inspect the resident's irrigation system for possible leaks. Discussion ensued. The Board agreed that there is no action to be taken and asked H2O to respond to the resident.

Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director Bumpass, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to authorize advertising for bids for recoating of the District's hydrotanks and to authorize Phase Four cleaning and televising of the District's sewer lines at an estimated cost of \$20,000.00.

In response to a question from the Board, Mr. Board stated that H2O is awaiting installation of AT&T internet access for remote monitoring abilities of the control panel SCADA screen at the water plant.

6. Engineer's Report. Mr. Carrigan presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "E."

A. 15557 FM 529 (Jejian Family Partnership – Automotive Mall): Mr. Carrigan reported that AECOM has reviewed plans submitted by the Jejian Family Partnership. Mr. Carrigan reviewed with the Board comments that have been sent to the engineer of the project, a copy of which is attached to the Engineer's Report. Extensive discussion ensued. Mr. Carrigan noted that AECOM has requested that the Jeijian Family Partnership provide design plans for internal plumbing.

B. Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation: Mr. Carrigan reported on summaries of contract time and amount due for phase 1 and 2 of the sanitary sewer rehabilitation of Copperfield Southpoint Sections 2 and Copperfield Southdown Village Section 4 and Section 6. Mr. Carrigan recommended that the Board approve Change Order No. 2, which reduces the contract price by \$2,162.00, and Pay Estimate No. 2 in the amount of \$8,747.40. Mr. Carrigan noted that the District will no longer hold 10% retainage in connection with the contract. Mr. Carrigan requested that the Board authorize execution of the Certificate of Completion for phase 1 and 2 of the sanitary sewer rehabilitation. Upon motion by Director Bumpass, seconded by Director Johnson, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve Change Order No. 2, reducing the contract price by \$2,162.00, to approve Pay Estimate No. 2 in the amount of \$8,747.40, and to authorize execution of the Certificate of Completion for phase 1 and 2 of the sanitary sewer rehabilitation.

Mr. Carrigan reported that phase 3 of the sanitary sewer rehabilitation is complete and that AECOM is awaiting additional phases to generate a complete project.

- 7. Discuss and authorize amendments to Rate Order. Mr. Hoffman presented to and reviewed with the Board a comparison of the District's water and sewer rates for multifamily residential units with those of HCMUD Nos. 179, 188, and 165, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "F." Mr. Hoffman noted that the District's current sewer rate per habitable multifamily unit is \$8.00. Discussion ensued. Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director Bumpass, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to amend the Rate Order to increase the District's sewer rate to \$12.00 per habitable multifamily unit.
- 8. Renew District Insurance. The Board reviewed a proposal from Highpoint Insurance Group, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "H." Discussion ensued. Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director Bumpass, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the proposal from Highpoint Insurance Group and to authorize the Board President to sign such proposal.
- 9. Indemnification of Directors. Ms. Cogburn stated that to the extent that the directors and officer's insurance policy does not cover losses of directors carrying out the lawful business and duties of the District in good faith, then the District can indemnify the directors for losses. Upon motion by Director Johnson, seconded by Director Bumpass, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve

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the District's indemnification of directors for losses arising from the directors carrying out their lawful duty, to the extent that such losses are not otherwise covered by insurance.

- 10. Review Issues Relating to Copperfield Joint Operations Board. Director Henderson reported that there was extensive discussion regarding the Operations Building. Mr. Carrigan reported that AECOM has received approval of plans for the Operations Building from Harris County and the City of Houston. Mr. Hoffman reported that there was discussion regarding sewer line repairs and extensive discussion regarding the District's current contract with Republic Services.
- 11. Other matters. Director Henderson stated that he will be transferring his ownership of property in the District and thus will no longer qualify as a Director. Discussion ensued regarding the appointment of a new Director to fill Director Henderson's position on the Board. It was the consensus of the Board to contact Mr. Andy Armstrong regarding the open position.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, the meeting was adjourned.

The foregoing minutes were passed and approved by the Board of Directors on September 16, 2014.

As District Engineer for HCMUD No. 186, we have reviewed the final plan submittal depicting external and internal water and sanitary sewer facilities for the above referenced project. We have the following comments that need to be addressed:

- The submitted plans are of external systems only and do not depict the work inside of the building. Please provide the plan sheets depicting the internal water and sanitary features. Please review the attached rate order and approval process manual for the complete requirements. The following items were not addressed in your submittal and should be addressed in you next submittal.
 - a. Provide a backflow preventer in accordance with the District's standards. Specify on plans.
 - b. Provide calculations for the size of the grease trap. Specify on the plans the specific grease trap rather than a detail for a typical grease trap.
 - c. Specify that the sampling well be per City of Houston drawing No. 516-S or 516-S-1.
 - d. Provide design calculation for sanitary and water lines.
 - e. Provide profile design for connection to district facilities.
 - f. Design shows sanitary line connecting to a private sanitary line. Provide documentation this connection is allowed and that you have permission to pave over the sanitary sewer easement.
 - g. If proposed meters are located in private property, an easement will need to be dedicated to the district for access and maintenance.
 - h. Provide a gate value at connection of the water line to the district's facilities.
 - i. Confirm water line design. Note the location of both 8-inch water lines crossing FM 529. See GIS image on next page. If water line is confirm in the field to be at the corner of the proposed property then design connection at this point else design a bore across FM 529 to connect to existing 8-inch line on north side of FM 529.



- i. Provide the following construction notes as applicable:
 - No connections shall be made to any facilities for water or sewer, until all fees for both taps and Reservations of Capacity have been made. Any unauthorized connections may be subject to uncovering, removal and reinstallation, and/or penalties.
 - H2O Consulting (281-861-6215) and AECOM (713-204-1129) must be notified in writing at least 2 working days advance of any construction.
 - All landscaping restoration including turf repair or establishment within public road rights-of-way must be coordinated with H2O Consulting (281-861-6215).
 This restoration will be at the developer's expense.
 - Taps to water and sewer facilities must be made by H2O Consulting.
 - All internal water and sewer construction must comply with the District's Rate Order and Standards.
 - All 100-year drainage construction must comply with Harris County Flood Control Standards.
- 2. The Operator, H2O Consultants, will physically connect to the district facilities, the water line to the meter box and will install all meters. The site development work will connect upstream of the meters.
