MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS September 10, 2019

THE STATE OF TEXAS

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 162 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, at 5870 Highway 6 North, Houston, Texas 77095, on September 10, 2019, at 3:00 p.m.; whereupon the roll was called of the members of the Board, to-wit:

Penny Johnson, President Susan McClure, Vice President Steve Rickelman, Treasurer Karen Odell, Secretary John Parrish, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Ms. Patty Rodriguez of Bob Leared Interests ("BLI"), tax assessor and collector for the District; Ms. Vanessa Hernandez of Myrtle Cruz, Inc. ("MCI"), bookkeeper for the District; Mr. Joshua Board of H2O Consulting ("H2O"), operator of the District's facilities; Ms. Alene Efaw of BGE, Inc. ("BGE"), engineers for the District; Mr. Greg Lentz of Masterson Advisors LLC ("Masterson"), financial advisor for the District; and Mr. Dimitri Millas and Ms. Shaila Sreedharan of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP ("NRF"), attorney for the District.

The President called the meeting to order in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of Certificates of Posting of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit A* and the following business was transacted:

- 1. Public Comments. There were no public comments.
- 2. Approve Minutes. Consideration was given to the approval of the minutes of the special and regular meetings of August 3, 2019, copies of which were previously distributed to the Board. Director Parrish requested a correction. Upon motion by Director Parrish, seconded by Director Odell, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the special meetings of August 13, 2019, as presented and of the regular meeting of August 13, 2019, as revised.
- 3. Receive recommendation from Financial Advisor for 2019 tax rate. The President recognized Mr. Lentz, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the recommendation for the 2019 tax rate, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*. Mr. Lentz recommended a debt tax rate of \$0.090 per \$100 assessed valuation to provide the District with sufficient funds to make debt service payments. Discussion ensued regarding the recommended debt service tax rate, the maintenance and operations tax rate, and the new tax legislation effective in 2020. Mr. Lentz also recommended a maintenance and operations tax rate of \$0.405 per \$100 assessed valuation.

4. Adopt Order Designating Officer to Calculate and Publish Tax Rate for 2019. Mr. Millas presented to and reviewed with the Board the Order Designating Officer to Calculate and Publish Tax Rates and Taking Other Actions in Connection with the Levy of a Tax for 2019, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit C*. Mr. Millas noted that the Order authorizes the tax assessor's office to publish a notice of the proposed tax rate and a public hearing with respect to the tax rate.

Upon motion by Director Rickelman, seconded by Director Parrish, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to propose a total tax rate of \$0.495 per \$100 assessed valuation, with \$0.090 for debt service, and \$0.405 for maintenance and operating expenditures, and to approve the Order Designating Officer to Calculate and Publish Tax Rates and Taking Other Actions in Connection with the Levy of a Tax for 2019.

5. Review Bookkeeper's Report and authorize payment of bills. Ms. Hernandez presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, the Investment Report, the Operating Budget, the Cash Flow Comparison and the Energy Usage Report, copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit D*.

Ms. Hernandez reported that the Certificate of Deposit at Bank Corp South was renewed for one year at an interest rate of 2.75%.

Upon motion by Director Odell, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Bookkeeper's Report, to authorize payment of check nos. 5866 through 5897 from the Operating Account, each in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes described in the Bookkeeper's Report, and to approve the Investment Report.

6. Review report by Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills. Ms. Rodriguez presented to and reviewed with the Board the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit E*. Ms. Rodriguez stated that as of August 31, 2019, the District has collected 98.8 of its 2018 taxes.

Ms. Rodriguez reported on the status of the District payment plans.

Ms. Rodriguez reviewed the delinquent tax report with the Board.

Upon motion by Director McClure, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report, to authorize payment of check nos. 1260 through 1262 from the Tax Account in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes described in the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report.

7. Review and approve Operations Report and authorize repairs. Mr. Board presented to and reviewed with the Board the Operations Report for the month of August 2019, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit F*. Mr. Board reported that the District pumped 884,000 gallons of water and purchased 12,427,000 gallons of water from the West Harris Regional Water Authority ("WHCRWA") during the last period. Mr. Board reported that the water accountability for the District was 94.29% for the month of August.

Mr. Board reported on the cover for the diesel storage tank.

Mr. Board reported that H2O repaired the forced ventilation fan in the chlorine room at a final cost of \$1,825.86.

Mr. Board reported that booster pump #3 will need to be repaired or replaced. He recommended that the Board replace the pump, stating that the cost difference between the repair and the replacement is approximately \$1,000.

Mr. Board reported on the operations building and the control building at the water plant. He stated that the roofs need to be repaired. Discussion ensued. Mr. Board presented a proposal from Mero Construction, LLC at a cost of \$9,431 to repair both roofs.

Mr. Board reported that H2O is scheduling the next round of the smart meter installations.

Mr. Board reported on the eight inch water main break on a shared line at Mesa Gardens and Branch Point. He stated that this will be a shared cost with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 186. Mr. Board reported that H2O removed the road and repaired the water line. He stated that there are three steel plates on the road and that BGE is working on a plan set to replace the road. He stated that the cost to date is \$5,873.40.

Mr. Board reported on a second water main break on Heather Bank, on an interconnect with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 188. He stated that the site is repaired and secured.

Mr. Board reported that H2O that the smoke testing in Middlegate is scheduled for the end of September.

Mr. Board reported that the new required bill message has been added to the water bill.

Upon motion by Director Parrish, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the replacement of booster pump no. 3 at a cost of \$6,733.

Upon motion by Director McClure, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the roof repairs at the water plant at a cost of \$9,431.

8. Review Engineer's Report. Ms. Efaw presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit G.

Ms. Efaw reported on the Mesa Gardens Drive pavement repair, stating that BGE will prepare construction plans that will need to be reviewed and approved by Harris County. She noted that a second set of construction plans will need to be prepared and submitted to Harris County for the water main break on Heather Bank.

Ms. Efaw reported that the sanitary line at Mesa Gardens cleaned and televised due to the break. She state that the videos are currently being reviewed.

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Upon motion by Director Parrish, seconded by Director McClure, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to authorize BGE to prepare the construction plans for the pavement repair at Mesa Garden Drive and Heather Bank.

- 9. Discuss District Insurance. Mr. Millas reported that the current insurance policies through Arthur J. Gallagher will expire on November 1, 2019. He asked the Board if they would like to request a renewal proposal from Arthur J. Gallagher or if they would like to request additional proposals from other providers. The Board concurred to request the renewal proposal from Arthur J. Gallagher.
- 10. Discuss Copperfield Joint Operations Board "CJOB" meeting. Mr. Board reported on the August CJOB meeting, stating that the Capital Improvement Plan ("CIP") was extensively reviewed. He reported on the major projects included in the CIP. Discussion ensued regarding the past revenue from the Hearthstone Country Club.

Mr. Board also reported that the lift station is operational.

11. Discuss extension of CJOB agreement and take any necessary action. Mr. Millas presented to and reviewed with the Board the CJOB agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit H*. He reported that all of the CJOB individual district attorneys have reviewed and approved the contract.

Upon motion by Director Odell, seconded by Director Rickelman, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the agreement with CJOB.

12. Review District website. Director McClure reported that she reviewed the website and that there are no issues.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED.

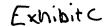

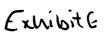

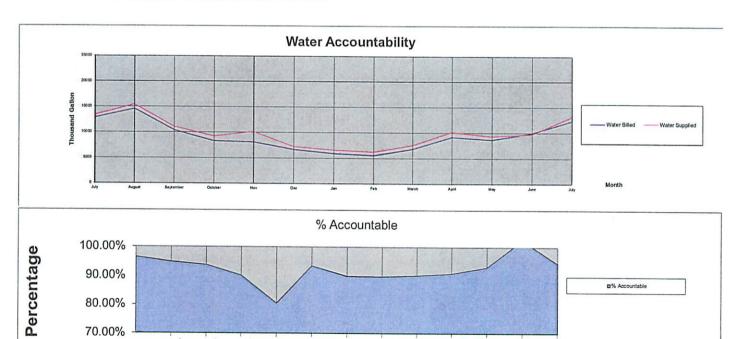

Overview

Preventive Services, LP was authorized to perform an evaluation to determine the coating integrity of the diesel storage tank. The tank is presently in service at Harris County M.U.D. No. 162 Water Treatment Plant. The field inspection was performed on August 28, 2019 and was made by visual and ultrasonic inspection of the tank exterior.

Exterior

Exterior Shell – The exterior of the diesel storage tank is in acceptable overall condition with a protective coating system that has failed on the top and underside of the tank. The protective coating has chalked, faded and is no longer self-cleaning. (See photos 1-4)

Support Saddle and Foundation – The concrete foundation was found to be in acceptable condition; no major defects were noted. Surface rust was bleeding from the metal tank support saddles. (See photo 5)

Defects – The protective coating system has failed on the top and the underside of the tank and surface rust is present. No substantial amount of metal loss was noted in the areas accessible for inspection. Impact areas with surface rust were noted on the sidewall areas. (See photos 6-13)

Interior

The interior protective coating system was not in the scope of this evaluation. No exterior manway.

<u>Ultrasonic Testing</u>

The ultrasonic readings taken indicate an average head thickness of 1/8" and a shell thickness of 1/8". There were no readings that indicate a major loss of base metal. Please see field record.

Recommendations

The exterior protective coating system has failed on the top and the underside of the tank. It is recommended to properly prepare and coat the exterior of the tank to prevent any future loss of base metal. If there is a problem with condensation or moisture in the tank, it is recommended to add a diesel fuel filter and water separator at the tank.

The interior protective coating system was not in the scope of this evaluation. No exterior manway.

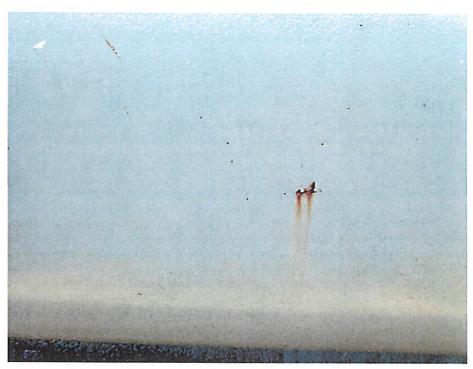

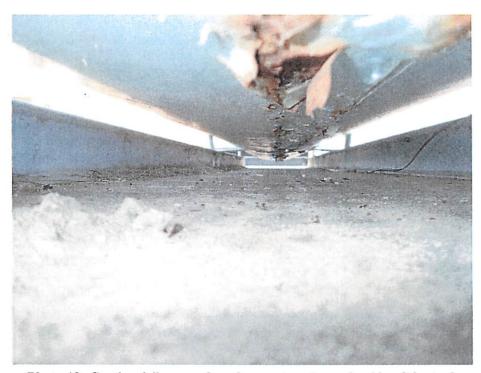
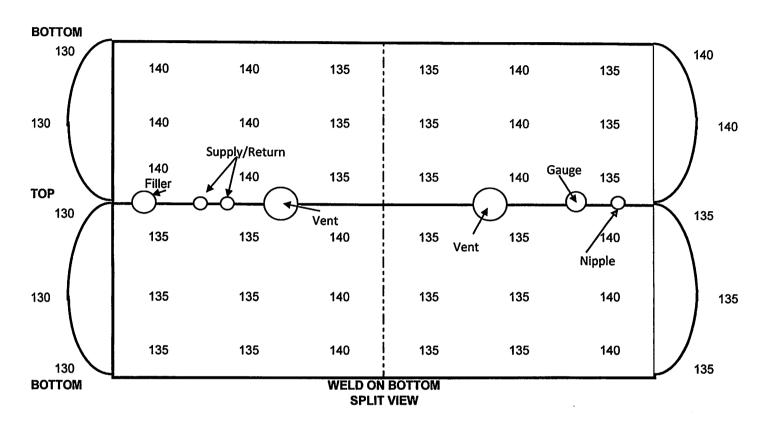

8. Review Engineer's Report:

1. Mesa Gardens Drive Pavement Repair – There was a main waterline break at Mesa Gardens Drive and Branch Point Drive. The waterline has been repaired by H2O. The waterline break caused a significant washout under the pavement. BGE will need to prepare construction plans to be reviewed and approved by Harris County Engineering.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are original signatories and parties to that certain Waste Disposal Agreement, dated November 1, 1979, as amended (the "Waste Disposal Agreement"), among No. 162, No. 163, No. 179, Friendswood Development Company, an Arizona corporation ("FDC"), and Carma Developers (Texas) Inc., a Texas Corporation ("Carma" and together with FDC, the "Developers"), filed for record in the Office of the County Clerk of Harris County, Texas, under Clerk's File No. G747367 and recorded under Film Code Reference No. 170 – 99 – 1263 et seq., or have become parties thereto by filing with the other parties thereto an Acceptance as therein provided, such Acceptances being individually for each of No. 186, No. 188, and No. 208, filed for record in the Office of the County Clerk of Harris County, Texas, under Clerk's File No. 8757769, 219511, and 041508, respectively, and recorded under Film Code Reference Nos. 178 – 96 – 2022, 200 – 81 – 2550, 052 – 92 – 0890, respectively, to which Waste Disposal Agreement and Acceptances and the record thereof is hereby made;

WHEREAS, the Waste Disposal Agreement had an original term of 40 years from the dated date of November 1, 1979, and the parties hereto desire to extend the original term of the Waste Disposal Agreement for 20 additional years;

WHEREAS, the Developers are no longer active participants in the Waste Disposal Agreement, and they will not be parties to this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants herein contained, and subject to the conditions herein set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

SECTION I. <u>Definitions</u>. All capitalized terms herein not otherwise defined in the recitals hereto or elsewhere herein shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms by the Waste Disposal Agreement.

SECTION II. <u>Recitals.</u> The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part hereof for all purposes and are adopted as part of this Agreement.

SECTION III. Extension of Term of Waste Disposal Agreement. The parties hereto agree to extend the term of the Waste Disposal Agreement for an additional 20 years, so that the Waste Disposal Agreement shall be in full force and effect and binding on the parties hereto until November 1, 2039.

SECTION IV. The Developers Not Parties to this Agreement. On November 1, 2019, all rights and obligations of the Developers under the Waste Disposal Agreement shall cease, and all references to the Developers in the Waste Disposal Agreement shall be disregarded and of no further effect.

SECTION V. <u>Effect on Other Agreements</u>. To the extent inconsistent with any other agreement to which any of the parties hereto may be a party, the terms hereof shall prevail and be controlling with respect to the matters agreed to herein between the parties. The terms and provisions of this Agreement contain the entire agreement with respect to the extension of term to the Waste Disposal Agreement
